

Cookie Management Policy

Cookie statement

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, we may collect certain traffic data and usage information to help us manage the content and improve your use of the Platform. This may include information about your equipment, your Internet Protocol (“IP”) address, and your browsing actions and patterns when you visit our Platform, including the referring and exit pages. The technologies that we use for this automatic data collection may include cookies that are stored on your computer, small embedded electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags and single-pixel gifs) and other types of embedded code on the Platform (collectively “cookies”) that permit us to count users and obtain other related Platform statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain Platform content and verifying system and server integrity).

Definitions

- “you” means an identified or identifiable living individual natural person to whom Personal Data relates and that is using the Website;
- “*Personal Data*” means any information relating to a data subject who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that data subject;
- “*Cookie Policy*” means this set of terms and conditions that regulates the use of cookies on the Website;
- “Website” means the Eton solutions website and the AtlasFive® software platform which includes tenant portal, client portal, admin portal and the mobile application;
- “*ETON*” or “we” means ETON Solutions, L.P and its subsidiaries and affiliates.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device’s hard drive when you visit a Website. Cookies are widely used to do different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improving your browsing experience. If you visit the Website, we will deploy these technologies to provide an online service more suited to the device you connect from, as

well as for administrative purposes and to enhance your online experience by keeping track of your behaviour within the Website.

Why do we use cookies?

We use a limited number of cookies for several reasons as listed in this Cookie Policy. Cookies are useful because they allow our Website to recognize the user's device. They are widely used in order to make the Website work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the Website. Without cookies, or some other similar method, websites would have no way to 'remember' anything about visitors.

We classify our cookies as:



a) Session cookies: Cookies that expire at the end of a browser session (normally when a user exits their browser) are called 'session cookies'. Session cookies allow Websites to recognize and link the actions of a user during a browsing session. They may be used for a variety of purposes such as remembering login status, or user preferences within the session.

b) Persistent cookies: Persistent cookies work by tracking your online preferences. But if you personalize the Website to fit your preferences, persistent cookies will remember and implement those preferences the next time you visit the Website such as storing your login information, language selections, menu preferences and internal bookmarks. These cookies can be disabled at your convenience.

c) First Party cookies: First Party cookies are small text file stored on your device by the Website. These cookies are essential for you to browse the Website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the Website.

d) Third Parties cookies: Third-party organizations may also use their own cookies or other technologies to collect information about the content of the Website that you have clicked on. This information may be used by them to serve advertisements that they believe are most likely to be of interest to you based on the content you have viewed.

– We do not have access or control over the cookies placed on the Website by third parties and the use of their cookies is subject to their own privacy policies.

– Cookies placed by third parties may serve different purposes. To manage or reject third-party cookies you must go to the relevant third party's website.

e) Strictly Necessary cookies: These cookies are essential, as they ensure your security and privacy when you use the Website, as well as enable you to move around the Website and use its features securely. Without these cookies, certain services on a website may not be made possible and a website may not perform as smoothly as it should perform. It expires as soon as the session is terminated, or when you exit the Website. This does not contain any information through which you can be identified. It is recommended that you do not disable these cookies.

f) Preference cookies: Preference cookies collect statistical information about the use of the Website, help to improve the way the Website works and to help us to identify issues you may have when using our online services. These cookies do not collect information that identifies a user personally and all information that is collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous. These cookies can be disabled at your convenience.

g) Marketing cookies: These cookies are required to create user profiles to track the user on a Website or across several websites for similar marketing purpose. These cookies may be set through the Website by our carefully selected and monitored advertising third-party partners. They may be used by those third-party partners to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant advertisements on other websites. These cookies can be disabled at your convenience.

Social networking cookies

These cookies are used to enable you to share pages and content that you find interesting on the Website through third-party social networking such as Facebook, Twitter, and other websites.

Links to other websites

When you are using the Website, you may be directed to other websites. These websites may use their own cookies. We do not have access or control over the placement of these cookies in other websites you visit, even if you are directed to them from the Website. If you access those other websites, please read any cookie or privacy statements on those websites to know what cookies are being used.

How can you Control Cookies?

You can set or amend your web browser controls to accept or refuse cookies. If you choose to reject cookies, you may still use the Website though your access to some functionality and areas of this Website may be restricted.
